

4th Grade Supply List

2010 - 2011

- 3 – 1” Three-ringed binders with clear plastic covers and pockets (inside)
- 1 – large zippered notebook
- 1 – pack of tabbed dividers
- 2 – packs of wide-ruled paper
- 3 – spiral (wide-ruled) notebooks
- 1 – pack of hole reinforcement labels
- 1 – 12 pack (plain yellow) #2 pencils
- 2 – plain erasers (white preferred)
- 2 – LARGE pencil grippers (sold in office). “Grotto” grippers are the only ones to be used this year.
- 2 – 12 inch ruler (inch and metric) flat plastic, metal, or wood – **no flexible types**. One is to be left at school, and one is to be left at home for math homework assignments that require rulers.
- 4 – packs of lined 3x5 cards
- 1 – pair of pointed scissors
- 1 – glue stick
- 1 – bottle of tacky glue or other craft glue
- 1 – box of colored pencils (**required**)
- 1 – pack of colored markers are optional
- 4 – **pocket** folders (**stiff** cardboard type instead of soft or plastic). *Try to avoid ones with math info inside.*
- 1 – pop-up top water bottle (**required**) with water only – **insulated type or bring a coaster**
- 2 – boxes of tissues
- 2 – rolls of paper towels
- 1 – container of disinfectant wipes
- 1 – small box of zip top plastic bags (sandwich size is OK)
- 2 – boxes of individual healthy snacks for class use (when students forget snacks)
- 3 – large stretch books covers for large hardback books
- 1 – book bag
- 1 – NASB Updated edition (New American Standard Bible – Updated Edition). Will be used for three years. This translation is required.

***Students will need 3-4 blue/black ballpoint pens for writing exercises They will also need **green ballpoint pens** for grading in class (on a daily basis). The green pens are difficult to find at a reasonable price for everyone, so we are asking parents to send \$3.00 cash (or check to: John Brown), and we will provide students all the pens (all colors) they will need for the entire year.
