Rhetoric I (11th Grade):

- 1 Notebook (This can be either a separate notebook for each class or a divided section in a larger binder. Just make sure you have somewhere to keep notes & handouts that are easily accessible.)

- Rhetoric Journal (Each Rhetoric student will need a "Commonplace" journal. This can be a spiral bound notebook or an actual bound journal; either will work fine.)
